

## **'Get Into Life' (Incorporates Certificate I in General Education for Adults)**

Get Into Life is a program that provides an opportunity for young people to improve their knowledge and skills in a relaxed adult learning environment. It is suitable for youth whom are either disengaged or at risk of being disengaged from education.

Get Into Life incorporates the Certificate I in General Education for Adults whereby the main focus is on the core units including Literacy and Numeracy. It also provides a framework for developing skills in a range of general and vocational areas as the students will participate in the assigned elective modules.

The flexibility of the CGEA curriculum is highly regarded in terms of its content and has been widely used throughout Australia by TAFE Institutes and Registered Training Organisations.

Get Into Life is run for a period of 12 months with students attending classes 3 days per week. We have intakes each term for Get Into Life.
